2. Whereas, the Central Government declared under section 3D (2) of the National Highways Act that on publication of the notification in the official Gazette, the land measuring 1.093 hectares specified in the schedule shall vest absolutely in the Central Government, free from all encumbrances.

3. Whereas, the amount of compensation for land and standing properties has been determined under section 3G of the National Highways Act, for the stretch from km 11+800 to km 12+600 vide Award No. 10/186/2022-REV(UKL)/0550 dated 22.06.2023 which has been revised by NHIDCL vide their letter 28.08.2023. Whereas, NHIDCL has deposited the compensation amount with the CALA account as intimated by GMP(P) NHIDCL, PMU-Ukhrul vide his letter NHIDCL/PMU-Ukhrul/LA/YUJNB/2022-23 dated 28.08.2023 for disbursement to the project affected persons (PAPs).

4. Accordingly, all the concerned affected persons/interested persons are hereby informed and notified that the compensation amount would be released and payment shall be made through RTGS or e-transfer to the respective bank accounts of the affected persons.

5. Therefore, all the concerned affected persons/villagers are directed to submit their bank account details immediately to the office of the undersigned (CALA) so that the compensation amount can be credited to their account within a week. Any failure to collect the compensation amount shall be deemed to have been paid on expiry of sixty days from the date of publication of this notice.

6. Now, therefore in exercise of power conferred by section 3E (1) of the National Highways Act, 1956, the competent authority hereby directs all the affected owners as well as any other persons who may be in possession of such land to surrender or deliver possession thereof to the competent authority within sixty days from today failing which such defaulters would be forced to surrender such land to the competent authority.
