



SWACHH BHARAT MISSION (GRAMIN)



OBSERVATION OF NATIONAL SANITATION CAMPAIGN, 25/9/2014 to 31/10/2014.

OBJECTIVES:

1. Creation of awareness to adopt safe sanitation.
2. The need to build and use sanitary toilets.
3. Adequate Toilets facilities in schools with separate provision for girls.
4. Importance of handwashing.
5. Safe disposal of Child Faeces.
6. Solid Liquid Waste Management and general cleanliness of villages.
7. Safe handling and storage of drinking water.

SWACHH BHARAT MISSION (SBM) - (GRAMIN)

Benefits to be given.

- To render all Gram Panchayat/Habitations" open defecation free" by 2019 AD by constructing 2 lakh (approximately) more sanitary toilets in Manipur by 2019 AD.
- Develop community managed environmental sanitation systems i.e. Solid & Liquid Waste Management in rural areas of Manipur.

Messages

- Sanitation is more important than Independence - (Mahatma Gandhi)
- A country will be developed when there is Sanitary Latrine in every household.
- Avoid open defecation; make a habit of using Sanitary latrines.
- Good Sanitation improves economy of the state.
- Safe disposal of child faeces.
- Handwash with soap after toilet, before food and after handling child faeces.
- One Gram of Faeces (human dung) contains 10,000,000 viruses, 1,000,000 bacteria and 1,000 parasite cysts (Source: UNICEF IYS Fact Sheet 2008).
- Keep villages clean all the times by effective management of solid and liquid waste.
- Contact Pradhan/Executive Engineers of PHE.D of the concerned district for construction of Sanitary Toilets.

NATIONAL RURAL DRINKING WATER PROGRAMME (NRDWP)

Benefits to be given.

- All 2870 habitations are to be given safe Drinking water by 2019 AD.
- Facilities for testing of Drinking water is available at District laboratories located in every district.
- Incentives will be given to the Village Water and Sanitation Committee for management, Operation & maintenance of Rural Water Supply Scheme.
- Ensure Water Source Sustainability at the local level.

Messages

- Water is Precious, Use Water judiciously.
- Drink safe water only to avoid illness.
- Rain water Harvesting, It is simple, Practice it, collect Rain water & use it.
- 60ft X 40ft area of GI Sheet Roofing can collect 3 lakh litres of water annually in Manipur.
- Conserve Water sources by afforestation for sustainability of water sources.
- Minimize use of Charcoal, use alternatives to conserve forest.
